A disciplinary committee will be an independent body that investigates misconduct, holds hearings, and enforces penalties for violations of rules, regulations, or codes of conduct by athletes, coaches, officials, and clubs. It ensures fair treatment, maintains the integrity of the sport, and imposes sanctions like suspensions, fines, or expulsions.

Key roles and responsibilities include:

- **Investigation and Adjudication:** Reviewing umpire decisions, citations, or complaints to determine if a breach occurred, often by reviewing evidence and hearing from all parties involved.
- **Applying Sanctions:** Pronouncing appropriate penalties, such as match bans, points deductions, fines, or expulsion, in accordance with the organization's regulations.
- **Maintaining Integrity:** Upholding the rules and ethics of the sport, including acting independently to resolve disputes.
- **Procedural Fairness:** Ensuring all individuals are treated with respect, consistently, and in accordance with principles of natural justice.
- **Interim Measures:** Implementing temporary actions, such as suspensions, while investigations are pending to protect the sport's integrity.

These committees often consist of legal and sport-specific members who operate independently from the executive board to ensure unbiased decisions.
